- **Samples** of your journalism-related work, such as clippings, photos, ad campaigns materials, videos, graphic design projects - or other work done as evidence of your journalistic ability.
- **Service** you have contributed to the Journalism Department and its programs; e.g., J-Days or Golf Tournament committees; student organization projects that assist the department (e.g., PRSSA, SPJ, Ad Club and others) will be weighed. Participation in Journalism Department programs and events is considered an indicator of your interest in your chosen field.
